Equipment Information and Rental Agreement

The following is a list of equipment that is mandatory for all skaters and must be on before skaters go on the ice.

- Helmet. A hockey, snowboard or skateboard helmet is acceptable. LAS or Louis Garneau do CSA approved speedskating helmets. **Bicycle helmets are not recommended.**
- Neck Guard. The bib style
- Gloves. Cut resistant gloves are recommended. No wool or knit gloves. (We sell kevlar liners)
- Shin guards. Hard plastic soccer shin guards. (not the ones with under foot straps)
- Knee pads. Volleyball pads work best
- Shatter proof glasses with strap. **Recommended for practice and required for meets.**
- Cut resistant tubes for ankle protection. **Required for meets**

Other Items

- Skate guards and softies. You must have these before taking rental skates.
- Laces. If the club skates have old laces please consider buying a set of waxed laces and a lace pick - your fingers will thank you.
- **Mats. Thankfully you don't need to buy these! Before the kids can go on the ice these need to be taken out of the store room and put on the ice, it is the responsibility of all parents to help.** There are some grips to go on shoes to keep you safe.

Skate Equipment Deposit

\$450 by post dated cheque to April 1st 2019 will not be cashed unless the skates have rust, are lost or damaged to a point where they are unuseable.

- You are responsible for the care of your skates.
- They must be dried with a towel after use and stored with soft covers on.
- You must wear skate guards at all times when walking off ice with skates on.
- Skates must be sharpened by hand (not at canadian tire). **This can be done by coaches or senior skaters for \$5. If you're not sure when they need doing check with a coach.**
