

Mission Racers Speed Skating Club

Athlete Code of Conduct

Welcome to the Mission Racers Speed Skating Club. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all Club members and associates, we ask all skaters and their parents/guardians to read and sign the Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct applies to all skate sanctioned activities both on and off the ice.

1. The Mission Racers Speed Skating Club expects all members to:
 - Treat others with courtesy and respect
 - Respect club equipment and the property of others
 - Be honest and forthright
2. The following behaviour is unacceptable for a member of the Mission Racers Speed Skating Club:
 - Bullying or intimidation
 - Harassment in any form
 - Committing any form of physical abuse
 - Using profane, disrespectful and abusive language including gestures
 - Prejudicial behaviour
 - Defiance of or rudeness to coaches, all ice officials, or chaperones
 - Destroying, damaging, or interfering with the property of others, or of the Club
3. The following is a list of immediate consequences for unacceptable behaviour. Some or all of these measures may be taken, and not necessarily in the order listed.
 - Verbal warning
 - On or off ice time out
 - Contact with parents/guardians
 - Suspension from club activities until further investigation can take place
4. Upon accepting his/her/their misbehaviour, a skater may make restitution through a verbal or written apology to the parties involved, along with a statement to the club executive that the offending action will not reoccur. If the skater is under 18 this apology must be witnessed and/or signed by the parent/guardian.
5. For persistent unacceptable behaviour, all or some of the following measures may be taken by the executive of the Mission Racers Speed Skating Club.
 - Withdrawal of any funding provided by the club
 - Suspension from practices and meets with no refund for the missed practices.
 - Expulsion from the Mission Racers Speed Skating Club with no refund.
6. Immediate suspension without warning will be enforced by the executive for serious infractions involving:
 - Overt or deliberate opposition, rudeness, attack, or threatening of any individual including, but not limited to, coaches, officials, chaperones, or fellow skaters.
 - Wilful destruction, or harm to property of another during all club sanctioned activities
 - Use of alcohol and/or drugs at any club sanctioned activity
7. Skaters under the age of 13 must have a parent/guardian or designated supervisor present during all club sanctioned activities including practices.
